

Ukrainian-Speaking Peer-Support Group Facilitator

Frankfurt (Oder) & Berlin

Hudara gGmbH is an independent and impartial organization working in situations where people's lives are impacted by poverty, conflict and climate change.We work on various projects to fulfill our mission (see hudara.org).

Two of these projects focus on mental health and well-being (one in Iraq and the other in Germany), promoting peaceful coexistence in communities. As part of our project in Germany (which is called GEZUMI), we invite people with migration backgrounds to join peer-support groups. These groups engage in activities that support mental health and well-being and address relevant topics like loneliness, discrimination, and administrative challenges. We also organize regular community events for both newcomers and long-term residents to connect and participate in meaningful and fun activities.

Within the scope of GEZUMI project, we are looking for two Ukrainianspeaking group facilitators who have migration backgrounds and can conduct peer-support interventions with other Ukrainian refugees and immigrants.

More specifically, we are looking for:

- One group facilitator residing in Frankfurt (Oder) and one group facilitator residing in Berlin, who have **native proficiency in Ukrainian (must)** and preferably good knowledge of English;
- Are currently studying/with a degree/with relevant experience in a mental health related field (e.g. Psychology, Social Work or other);
- Personal migration background is necessary for this role;
- Experience and skills in the delivery of group work or a strong desire to learn;
- Communication skills, flexibility and intercultural sensibility;
- Genuine interest in supporting people on their path towards mental healing and wellbeing;
- Knowledge of or interest to learn about group therapeutic approaches and principles of self-help and peer-support;

What we offer:

- Part time (40%) employment (or Honorar-basis) on site in Frankfurt (Oder)/Berlin with 2 days / 16 working hours a week;
- Regular online trainings and support sessions; occasional short trips to Hudara's office in Berlin;
- Duration: 6 months with possibility of extension;
- Starting date: 01.07.2024;
- Salary: 1100 EUR Brutto;
